# SAMPLE BEQUEST LANGUAGE

A gift to Baldwin in your will or revocable trust proclaims your confidence that we will continue to serve our mission and make a difference in the lives of future generations of Baldwin students. A bequest:

- is easy to arrange,
- will not alter your current lifestyle in any way, and
- can be easily modified to address your changing needs.

## **Residual Bequest Language**

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

*I give and devise to The Baldwin School, a not-for-profit-organization located in Bryn Mawr, Penn., all (or state a percentage) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).*

## **Specific Bequest Language**

Naming Baldwin as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:

*I give and devise to The Baldwin School, a not-for-profit-organization located in Bryn Mawr, Penn., the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (or asset) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).*

## **Contingent Bequest Language**

Baldwin can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:

*If (insert name) is not living at the time of my demise, I give and devise to The Baldwin School, a not-for-profit-organization located in Bryn Mawr, Penn., the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (or all or a percentage of the residue of my estate) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).*
